THE THIRD TRANSNATIONAL MEETING

The meeting that was held in Potenza on June 24th focused on the next steps that will be taken in order to fully implement the project. Over the following weeks the partners will devote their time and energies to finetune the details for the video festival, the development of the card game, guide completion and focused group session.

THE NEXT STEPS...

The objective of the video festival is the creation of engaging videos featuring inspiring women in STEM, with each partner providing 4-5 videos, 3 to 6 mins long. The videos will be both in the national language and in English, using YouTube's automatic subtitle translation. One video per country will be broadcast during the festival.



As previously agreed, the card game will be of the "Who's Who" type. Business-sized cards will bear the face and name of 50 inspiring STEM ladies, plus a set of questions aimed at furthering the topic . Each partner is asked to provide 9 cards. Geoclube has already shared a Canva template to help in the process. The game will be supported by an accompanying bilingual book. YES will digitalize the card game and will also provide links to Erasmus Me Academy for online accessibility. The partners are all working on the translation of the guide into their national language, with deadline being on July 29th.

Finally, focused group and pilot sessions have been planned. Six STEM experts per partners will participate in the focused group sessions. Feedback from the sessions will be an integral part of the guide.

As for the pilot sessions, they will be joined by teachers and students alike. The goal is to test the card game and provide useful reviews that will also find their way into the guide. There will be two sessions, one for teacher presentation and one for student gameplay. The outcome of the pilot sessions will be disseminated via social media. The sessions-related activities are to be completed before the international training set for October 2024.
